A violist of Romanian origin, Teodor Coman is soloist of the «Orchestre National de France ». Previously, he was also appointed principal viola of the «Orchestre National de l’Ile de France».

First prize at the High Music Academy in Bucharest, he won six first prizes at the National Viola Competitions of Romania, as well as the Second «Grand Prix» at the International «Maurice Vieux» Competition in Lille. He also obtained the «National

Diploma of High Studies of Music» in Bucharest. He then recorded regularly on Radio and Television of Romania.

Upon his arrival in France, he played often in concertos, as a soloist, with the «Orchestre National de l’Ile de France».

Passionate about chamber music, he frequently plays with renowned soloists.

Currently based in Paris, he also became a member of the "Trio à Cordes de Paris", then of the "Arpeggione Quartet" and "Renoir Quartet" with which he often toured.

Teodor Coman plays on a viola made by F.H. Chaudière and also teaches at the Ecole Normale de Paris and the CRR in Rueil-Malmaison.

Since 2015, he has been a member of the "Nouveau Trio à Cordes de Paris".



Currently based in Paris, Serbian pianist Jasmina Kulaglich is Naxos’ and Calliope’s recording artist. Soloist with the European Romantic Orchestra in Paris, UK Symphony Orchestra in London, chamber orchestras in France, she performs also in chamber music with soloists of the “Orchestre de Paris”, “Orchestre Philharmonique de Radio France”, “Orchestre National de France”. Her “Trio Bohème” released the Calliope CD “The

Season” with the Tchaikovsky / Piazzolla program and received outstanding reviews across Europe.

Nurtured by the traditions of the Russian school of pianists, and then that of Claudio Arrau, she is performing in France (Salle Gaveau, Salle Cortot, Cziffra Foundation, Goethe Institut), Great Britain (London, Leister), Switzerland (Geneva, Lausanne, Neuchatel), Italy, Holland, Belgium, the USA...

Jasmina Kulaglich released the Naxos CD « Byzantine Mosaic » in the World Premiere, presenting the Serbian composer Svetislav Bozic. The CD received, among others, the highest award from the famous Belgium classical magazine « Crescendo » and still attracts attention from critics for its originality.
